# SNOW REMOVAL



Residence who live along Hi-way 800 CANNOT pile snow on 'Alberta Transportation Provincial Highway Right of Ways.' The Right of Way is 1/2 meter on the west side of the power poles thru to 1/2 meter on the East side of the power poles. Alberta Transportation has notified the Village Office. This is a safety liability issue and it will be enforced through provincial charges. Charges will be issued from Alberta Transportation to the property owner removing the snow.

The Village is also requesting that snow not be piled on the boulevards as it creates a drainage issue in the spring. If you want to remove snow it must be stored on your own property or hauled away at your expense.
