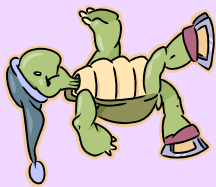

Hill Spring Rec Board

The Hill Spring Recreation Board is no longer a committee of council. They have become a Society established under its own bylaws.. Utilities

At the December council meeting, Village Council approved a new water rate schedule as follows:

Residential—(per billing) water—	\$80.00
sewer—	\$12.50
garbage —	\$13.50
Irrigation—	\$9.00
TOTAL—	\$115.00
Rural—(per billing) water—	\$100.00
Institutional—(per billing) - water—	\$180.00
sewer—	\$70.00

Starting in 2012 we will be metering the water usage. A water operator will be around in the next little while to do a base reading. Consumption reading will be billed as per rate schedule. If you have any issues with your water meter or would like to have it checked out please contact the Village Office.

Off Highway & Snowmobile Bylaw

At Dec. Council meeting , Council passed an “Off Highway Vehicle Bylaw” & “Snowmobile Bylaw.” This authorizes the usage of off highway vehicles and snowmobiles within the Village limits in accordance to Alberta Traffic Safety Act and their bylaws.
